Our MLAOC exhibit organized by Matt Lockett featured a full spectrum of well restored motors from 1918 thru to the 1960's. The highlights included an extremely rare Indian Silver Arrow displayed by Ted Moss. A wide variety of brands were represented. The diversity and quality of our display was well received by the public and greatly appreciated by the ACBS Show organizers.

The second important attribute of the 2018 Show was the featuring of vintage Fibreglass boats. A special award was created in memory of fiberglassic boat restorer and advocate, Ronny Haylock. This award was presented to the boat judged Best Classic Glass at the Show. The Award was won by Bill & Brenda Sumner for their 1959 Glastron, "Stand by Me". There were a total of 25 FiberGlassics in the water and on land. Of these, 20 were outboard powered, the majority with period correct outboard motors.
