
The criteria include:

- Have worked for the "greater good" of the MLAOC without concern for immediate benefit and reward for themselves.

This years deserving recipient is Dana Torch.
The Award was presented to Dana by Ken Kirk at our AGM in Aurora on Oct. 14.

Dana has made major contributions to MLAOC in two very important areas. First as our Social Media Coordinator and second, by creating a major MLAOC Swap Meet that has become an annual event and by taking the lead in representing MLAOC in displays at major events in Eastern Ontario.

Four years ago, your Steering Committee, recognized that Social Media was becoming a significant communication tool particularly among the younger demographic. We called for volunteers to develop an MLAOC Social Media platform & presence. Dana stepped forward.

Within a short space of time Dana had us up and running in the digital space. Today MLAOC has 885 Facebook followers and growing.

Dana has developed a second tier for "Members Only". This space now has 77 members. We average more than 2 posts per day. Dana has developed a much broader content profile for the "Members Only" tier. This includes full photo coverage for past events plus Technical Seminar Videos that were originally shot live at MLAOC Technical Seminars conducted by Ron Stevenson, Peter McDowell and Steve Silverthorn several years ago. Dana has taken the video raw footage, edited into concise, easy to understand videos and posted them on our "Members Only" page. A major job which took considerable time, effort and skill to execute and publish.

Dana has also been an aggressive event organizer. Six years ago, Dana originated the Eastern Ontario Swap Meet which he hosted at his home on Stoco Lake, near Tweed. This has become a great success and is now an Annual MLAOC Event, even surviving the COVID years. This event has increased our profile in Eastern Ontario and has brought in new MLAOC members from the region.
